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Executive Summary

This is a summary of the Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA) completed by the Canadian Air Transport Security Authority (CATSA) for *InfoNet*; an online portal that facilitates the exchange of information between CATSA and its third party Screening Contractors. InfoNet is expected to simplify and automate the existing ad hoc exchange of information between CATSA and its Screening Contractors.

Scope of PIA

The scope of this PIA was restricted to the business processes and data flows of personal information related to:

1. InfoNet's creation and management of user accounts,
2. How InfoNet users will be granted access privileges to the various systems and applications that are hosted on InfoNet, and
3. The existing systems and data sets that Screening Contractors have access to via InfoNet.

The approach for completing this PIA included a review of related documentation, completing the *TBS PIA Questionnaire A: For Federal Programs and Services*, as well as interviews with relevant CATSA subject matter experts.

Privacy Risks & Mitigation Strategies

The PIA uncovered a limited number of privacy risks. Appropriate mitigation strategies for these risks were recommended and accepted by program management. The implementation of these mitigation strategies is complete and/or ongoing.

Conclusion

In December 2013 a copy of this PIA was submitted to the Office of the Privacy Commissioner (OPC) for review. The OPC has since responded with no additional risks to privacy or specific recommendations.
